Tuition/Extended Care Payments: Tuition is divided into 2 equal payments. The first payment (total for sessions one and two) is due on June 15. The second payment (total for sessions three and four) is due on July 15. These payments can be broken up into 2 monthly payments if desired. Discounts: 10% tuition discount is offered for current membership in ANY Sonoma County Synagogue. 3% Multiple sibling discount is offered for concurrently enrolled siblings and applies to second (and third, etc.) sibling. Discounts apply ONLY to TIERS, not enrichment. Only one discount may apply per family.

Enrichment: There may be some enrichment classes over the summer.

School Closures: School is closed for one week before camp (June 3-7 for teacher clean-up week) and for two weeks after camp (August 5th to 9th for campus restoration cleaning, and August 12th to the 16th for teacher set-up week) before school starts in the fall. School will also be closed on July 4. **There are NO discounts or reimbursements for these dates.**

Important Dates and Deadlines

Monday, January 21 – Priority Registration for Returning Families Begins

Monday, February 04 – Registration for New Families Begins (Returning families may still apply, but will lose priority after this date).

Wednesday, May 1 – Summer Applications due. *After this date, we cannot give refunds for dropped days for summer sessions 1 and 2.* Adding days may be possible if ratios allow.

Friday, June 14 – Deadline to drop days for a refund for summer sessions 3 and 4. Adding days may be possible after this point if ratios allow.

Monday, June 10 – First day of summer camp

Friday, June 15 – Summer Payment #1 (Sessions 1 and 2 Tuition)

Sunday, July 15 – Summer Payment #2 (Sessions 3 and 4 Tuition)

Friday, August 2 – Last day of summer camp, Pick up at 1pm no Extended Care.
