We meet in the parking lot at Beth Ami at 10:00 AM to carpool and meet those arriving on their own at the parking lot of the Visitors Center at 11:30 AM unless it is pouring rain. Bring food to eat, and share something involving nuts and fruits that come from trees. Also bring a poem to share about trees. We will walk on a wheelchair and stroller accessible nature trail to the picnic area where we will eat lunch and share our poems.

We'll have the option of returning to the parking lot via a trail going up and over to a creek and back down to meet the nature trail and back to the cars. The others may return the way they came on the flat trail among the trees. Anyone who wants a longer walk is free to take any of the Park trails but keep in mind how early it gets dark. This is suitable for all ages and we invite the Nursery School parents to join us and bring their children.

If the free parking lot at the Visitors Center is full drivers can pay the \$8.00 day use fee at the kiosk and drive to the Picnic Area or park long the road leading into the Park. Other things to do in the area include a visit and tour of Korbel Winery (where we get our brandy from) followed by a complimentary tasting of their wines. They have a deli but it is not kosher. If it is raining, at 10:00 AM we can meet and stay in the multi purpose room.
