Extended Day Care for children of all ages is available Monday through Friday from 7:30 a.m. - 9:00 a.m. and from 1:00 p.m. - 5:30 p.m. For the 2's afternoon care begins at 12:00 p.m. The rate is \$7.25 per hour. Please see the Extended Day Care enrollment form.

Application/Registration Fee: \$100.00 non-refundable for new and returning students.

Parent Work Hours: Over the course of the school year, each family is responsible for completing a minimum of only five hours of parent "work time" per child enrolled. Families can fulfill these hours in many ways by April 30th of the current school year or may choose the option of paying \$20 per hour in May, in lieu of their time.

Limited scholarships are available for the pre-school: Applications are available in the BACNS office and are due no later than July 1, 2014, for a determination for the coming school year. If you wish to learn how you can make a gift (donation) of an extra day/week for a child to attend BACNS, please see our Director and learn more about the Jill Tager Scholarship Fund. This year, between the Jill Tager Fund and the Jewish Community Federation, approximately \$1000 a month was provided in scholarships to our families.
