Tuition/Extended Care Payments: Tuition is divided into 2 equal payments. The first payment (total for sessions one and two) is due on June 15. The second payment (total for sessions three and four) is due on July 15. Extended Care payments are billed on the first of the month starting on July 1 for sessions 1 and 2, and on August 1 for sessions 3 and 4.

Discounts: 10% tuition discount is offered for current membership in ANY Sonoma County Synagogue. 3% Multiple sibling discount is offered for concurrently enrolled siblings and applies to second (and third, etc.) sibling. Discounts apply ONLY to CORE tuition and not to extended care or enrichment. If multiple discounts apply, synagogue, then sibling discounts will be taken in that order.

Enrichment: There may be some enrichment classes over the summer.

School Closures: School is closed for one week before camp (June 4-8 for teacher clean-up week) and for two weeks after camp (August 6-10 for campus restoration cleaning, and August 13-17 for teacher set-up week) before school starts in the fall. School will also be closed on July 4 and August 1. **There are NO discounts or reimbursements for these dates.**

Important Dates and Deadlines

Monday, January 29 – Priority Registration for Returning Families Begins

Tuesday, February 12 – Registration for New Families Begins (Returning families may still apply, but will lose priority after this date).

Monday, May 14 – Summer Applications due. *After this date, we cannot give refunds for dropped days for summer sessions 1 and 2.* Adding days may be possible if ratios allow.

Wednesday, June 16 – *Deadline to drop days for a refund for summer sessions 3 and 4.* Adding days may be possible after this point if ratios allow.

Monday, June 11 – First day of summer camp

Friday, June 15 – Summer Payment #1 (Sessions 1 and 2 CORE tuition)

Sunday, July 1 – Summer EDC Payment #1 (Sessions 1 and 2 EDC)

Sunday, July 15 – Summer Payment #2 (Sessions 3 and 4 CORE)

Wednesday, August 1 – Summer EDC Payment #2 (Sessions 3 and 4 EDC)

Friday, August 3 – Last day of summer camp
