Passover begins the evening of Friday, March 30, 2018

In preparation for Passover it is customary to either get rid of all hameitz (flour, food or drink made from the prohibited species of leavened grain: wheat, oats, barley, rye or spelt) or to sell it to a non-Jew and repurchase it after Passover. If you wish to sell your hameitz, please contact the Beth Ami office or download the form from http://bethamisr.org/wp-content/uploads/2018/03/Passover-Sale-of-Hametz-2018.pdf and return it to the office before 10:00 AM, Friday, March 30.

During Passover we have the following special services in addition to the Community Seder and our regular Shabbat and daily services. Please note that the lunches after Shabbat services during Passover are **NOT a potluck**. A simple lunch of Passover food will be provided. If you wish to contribute something you may bring a Kosher for Passover item in an <u>unopened</u> container or make a donation to the office for Shabbat lunches. Be sure that it is <u>not</u> marked as containing Kitniyot. **We cannot serve anything prepared at home**.

<u>March 25-April 7 – Kitchen may be used for Passover food only</u>

March 30 (Fri) – 7:30 am (after 7:00 morning service) Fast of the First Born followed by a light breakfast.

April 6 (Fri) – 9:30-12:00 am Seventh Day service

6:30 pm Shabbat and 8th day evening service (NO DINNER)

April 7 (Sat) – 9:30 am-12:30 am Shabbat morning and 8th day service with YISKOR

followed by Kosher for Passover dairy lunch (not a potluck)

8:00 pm service for end of eighth day (end of Passover)

8:30 pm sell back Hameitz
